# LEARN-TO-SWIM PROGRAM

## Level I (Water Exploration):

This is for children aged five years and older. The focus will be on water entry, exit, buoyancy and increasing comfort in the water.

**Session 1** starts at 11:00 am

**Session 2** starts at 5:00pm

## Level II (Primary Skills):

Focus on basic front and back stroke elements, buoyancy, streamlining, floating & breath control.

**Session 5** starts at 5:30pm

## Level III (Stroke Readiness):

Focus on basic stroke development (front crawl, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly and elementary backstroke), diving and treading water.

## LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION

This course will teach the skills needed to become a professional lifeguard. Course participants must be at least 15 years old by the date of the first class. Participants must attend all three days of the course.
