
RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Every patron must scan a valid member identification card at the reception desk and leave that card at the lifeguard desk upon arrival.
2. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied and **ACTIVELY** supervised by an adult Member.
3. If a patron is going to engage in an activity other than lap swimming or wading (including aqua-jogging in the diving well or other rehabilitation exercises), a lifeguard must be notified before the activity begins. **Extended underwater breath holding is not allowed.**
4. No running or horseplay on deck, in the pool or in the locker rooms. No tag, dunking or pushing into the pool. No headfirst diving in the lap pool. Please review posted rules.
5. Use of the 3-meter diving board is **NOT** included with Recreational Swim Membership. The 1-meter diving board is open only when posted as open. Separate diving well rules are well posted.
6. Spitting, spouting water, blowing your nose or discharging bodily waste in the pool is prohibited.
7. Infants and toddlers who are not potty trained **MUST** wear a swim diaper.

We recommend consulting with a physician before starting any exercise program. You should cease exercising and contact a member of our staff if you experience symptoms (e.g., dizziness, nausea lightheadedness, disorientation, exhaustion) which may signal a serious medical condition.

- Lafayette College reserves the right to revoke or suspend pool privileges when pool rules are broken or behavior is disruptive.
- Members can use a day locker while swimming located in the Natatorium locker rooms.
